Fuel Cells

Fuel Cell Electricity: First used by NASA to provide electricity, heat and drinking water in spacecraft during the 1960s.

1. Fuel cells have become one of our most promising clean energy technologies.
2. Fuel cells already provide primary and back-up power for hotels, hospitals, manufacturing plants and retail shopping centers.
3. Many major car manufacturers have developed demonstration vehicles that incorporate fuel cells.
4. Fuel cell buses are in service in some California cities, shuttling residents without the use of gasoline.
5. Fuels such as coal, oil and natural gas are non-renewable.
6. When renewable energy sources are used, demand for fossil fuels is reduced.
